# Clyde's key for Knicks: It's 'consistency, man'

Nobody represents Knicks success quite like Walt "Clyde" Frazier.

The Hall of Famer won two NBA titles with the Knicks, cementing his legacy as the team's greatest point guard. Now a color analyst alongside play-by-play announcer Mike Breen on MSG, Frazier, 65, spoke with amNewYork about a slew of popular NBA topics:

**What's your assessment of the Knicks?** Consistency, man. Can they continue to make the 3-ball? When the Knicks are making the 3-ball, they can beat anybody. Obviously, Gallo [Danilo Gallinari] has come out of his funk.

**What player other than Amar'e Stoudemire is most critical to their success?** [Raymond] Felton. He's the orchestrator, he's got to create and get the ball to the right guys. Also, your first line of defense

starts with the backcourt. So, he's that type of guy — very tenacious.

**How fierce was trash-talking on the court when you played?** Our philosophy was let a sleeping dog lie. [Laughs] You don't want to wake him up, man. You're killing the team. You don't do anything to arouse him. We played with more savvy than the guys today.

**Where do you stand on the NBA's emphasis on technical fouls?** I thought it was necessary. There was too much complaining. But there has to be a happy medium. Right now, there's hostility with the players and officials. It's not good for the game.

**When will you know the energy in MSG is back?** When Mike is saying something and I can't hear him. [Laughs]

## Boss and Billy reach HOF ballot

Shortly after the death of George Steinbrenner, the Yankees honored the owner with a plaque in Monument Park.

He could soon be honored with one in Cooperstown. Steinbrenner, who died in July at age 80, will appear on the Hall of Fame's Expansion Era Committee ballot next month, as will

the manager he hired and fired serially, Billy Martin.

The Hall announced yesterday that former union head Marvin Miller also will be on the ballot, as well as retired Blue Jays, Phillies, Orioles

and Phillies general manager Pat Gillick. The players will be Vida Blue, Dave Concepcion, Steve Garvey, Ron Guidry, Tommy John, Al Oliver, Ted Stimmans and Rusty Staub. To be elected, a candidate must appear on at least 75 percent of the 16 veterans committee ballots. Results will be announced Dec. 6 at the winter meetings in Florida. (NEWSDAY)
